A NOTE FROM THE DIRECTOR/ARTISTIC DIRECTOR



Much of this play takes place in and around the Globe Theatre –often in the back rooms, where tears, laughter, and memories are all liberally shared. The actors, managers, and families of the King's Men can't escape these spaces.

I deeply understand that perspective. In times of joy or distress, I've found myself needing to be in a theatre. Once, after hearing a shelter-in-place order, I left the cafe I was in without thinking for the comfort of a theatre. When we lost a pillar of our theatrical community a few years ago, several

artists gathered at theatres across the city to tell stories, laugh, and mourn. When the restaurants were closed last year, Matt and I each celebrated Valentine's Day here with our partners.

Frankly, the Lyric Stage is my Globe Theatre. Twenty years ago, Stage Manager Nerys Powell, Sarah Newhouse, and I worked on *The Miracle Worker*—my first show at the Lyric Stage. Over the years, I've directed Will McGarrahan to play a director in *Stage Kiss* and Fred Sullivan Jr. to seduce his wife with mashed potatoes in *The Cake*. Six months ago, scenic designer Janie Howland, assistant director Alex Smith, Shani Farrell, and I worked on *Be Here Now*, my tenth show at the Lyric Stage.

The theatre is our place. Before, during, and after a rehearsal or performance, the theatre is where we think, share, grieve, and celebrate–it's where we feel.

More than a play about how to make a book or how to honor Shakespeare's works, this story is a love letter to what bonds us as artists to the stage. Thank you for being here, in our Globe, and letting us tell our story.


Lauren Gunderson (Playwright) was awarded the 2016 Lanford Wilson Award from the Dramatist Guild, the 2016 Otis Gurnsey Award for Emerging Writer, and the prestigious 2014 and 2018 Steinberg/ATCA New Play Award for her plays, *I and You* and *The Book of Will*. She co-authored the play Miss Bennet: Christmas at Pemberley with Margot Melcon. Bauer, commissioned by San Francisco Playhouse, premiered there and in New York City at 59E59. Her play, Silent Sky, premiered at South Coast Rep in 2011 and was further developed and rewritten for TheatreWorks. Her world premiere of Exit, Pursued By A Begr has reached over 20 communities across the United States, winning "Best Comedy" accolades. Other works include Toil and Trouble, The Taming, her first musical, The Amazing Adventures of Dr. Wonderful and Her Dog!, Emilie: La Marquise Du Chatelet Defends Her Tonight, By and By, and Firework. Her first children's book based on Dr. Wonderful was released by Two Lions Publishing in 2017. She has developed plays with Second Stage, Red Bull, and Primary Stages in New York City; New Repertory Theatre in Boston; Playwrights Foundation, Crowded Fire, TheatreWorks, Aurora Theatre, and The Magic Theatre in San Francisco; Kitchen Dog Theater in Dallas; Synchronicity, Actor Express, and Horizon Theatre in Atlanta; JAW at Portland Center Stage in Portland; WORDBridge, Brave New Works, and others. Her work has received national praise and awards, including a Steinberg/ATCA New Play Award finalist, a Susan Smith Blackburn finalist, a Jane Chambers Award finalist, and winner of the Berrilla Kerr



Award for American Theatre, Global Age Project, Young Playwright's Award, Eric Bentley New Play Award, and Essential Theatre Prize.

Courtney O'Connorº (Director/Artistic Director) joined the full-time staff of the Lyric Stage in 2018 and was named Artistic Director in 2020. She has directed several pieces for the Lyric Stage, including Stones in His Pockets, Red Hot Patriot, The Cake, and Be Here Now. Courtney is a senior affiliated faculty member in Performing Arts at Emerson College. In addition to directing for theatres and universities, Courtney has directed multiple sitespecific productions at locations including Mount Auburn Cemetery and Boston's Old State House. Through her work with the Coyote Theatre Project, she oversaw the creation of more than 200 new 10-minute plays written by youths from Boston. Courtney has received the Elliot Norton award for her work as the Associate Director on the Lyric Stage's production of The Life and Adventures of Nicholas Nickleby and the Alan L. Stanzler Award for Excellence in Teaching.





LYRIC STAGE

The Lyric Stage Company of Boston produces and presents live theatre in Greater Boston with an intimate approach that promotes inclusivity and connection. The Lyric Stage leads an effort to integrate live theater and theater education into the lives of all residents of Greater Boston.

Founded in 1974 by **Ron Ritchell** and **Polly Hogan**, the Lyric Stage is Boston's oldest resident theatre company. After establishing a loyal following on Charles Street, Ron and Polly led a successful 1991 campaign to create the Lyric Stage's current home on Clarendon Street. Polly was the chief negotiator for the NEAT (New England Area Theatres) contract, which made it easier for local producers to hire members of Actors Equity Association, the union for actors and stage managers.

In 1998, **Spiro Veloudos** was appointed Producing Artistic Director. During his tenure, he continued Ron and Polly's commitment to local artists; with few exceptions, the theatrical artists that work at the Lyric Stage live in the Greater Boston area. Spiro also established a reputation for staging large musicals in the Lyric Stage's modest playing space, including a signature Sondheim Initiative, which covered 10 musicals over 20 years.

In 2016, the Lyric Stage opened Clarendon Hall, a year-round rehearsal space. Clarendon Hall is available at a subsidized rate to members of the Boston Dance Alliance and other arts organizations and individuals.

Theatre-based education has been a core of the Lyric Stage's mission since its founding days. In 2019, the Lyric Stage merged with City Stage Co. and its expanded education programs include performances at the Children's Museum of Boston, teaching artists working in classrooms in the Boston Public Schools, and the Lyric First Page playwriting festival for students.

Following Spiro's retirement in 2019, the board appointed **Matt Chapuran** as Executive Director, and shortly after, **Courtney O'Connor** was named Artistic Director. Their partnership centers Lyric Stage in Boston's theatrical community, introduces live theatre to new audiences, and promotes new theatrical voices in Boston and nationwide.
