- Optional: Include Setting and Time

All three run stage right. Then they turn around and run back stage left.

We gotta get outa here.

They look around for an exit. AYANNA suddenly notices a football on the ground. She picks it up.

AYANNA

Hey, Papi. Go long.

BIG PAPI runs offstage right. TOM follows.

AYANNA

Keep going!
